BOROONDARA NETBALL ASSOCIATION JUNIOR NETBALL POLICY

RE: 13U and 15U REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

The Boroondara Netball Association is affiliated with Netball Victoria and, as such, must operate within the guidelines and objectives of the "Netball Victoria Junior Netball Policy".

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

- 13U and 15U Representative teams are classified as 'developmental teams', the focus being on broad skill development not specialisation.
- Participation in finals of the 13U & 15U age group may be a player's first exposure to 'representative team finals' and every effort should be made to make it a positive experience.
- At all times, efforts must be made so as not to preclude any child from participating.
- Rewards should be for participation, individual achievement, sportsmanship and improvement.
- Coaches may feel that there is no challenge for themselves and their players if they are not trying to get into and win finals. However there are many challenges a coach can set her players that are not dependent on a win or a place in a grand final refer Coach Director for guidelines.
- All coaching should be by qualified personnel minimum requirement for POWER teams = Development

STATEMENT re matches:

The focus in all games is not just on winning but on providing a positive experience to all players who have been selected into our Association Talent Identification Program.

All players in the 13U and 15U age groups must participate in <u>at least 2 quarters of every game</u> - unless there are extenuating circumstances which include injury, <u>non-attendance at training or poor attitude</u> - and all players must be made to feel that they have been worthy contributors to the game.

STATEMENT re finals:

The focus in finals is on winning but also on providing a positive experience to all players who have been selected into our Association Talent Identification Program.

All players in a 13U & 15U representative team must participate in <u>at least 1 quarter of all finals</u> – unless there are extenuating circumstances which include injury, <u>non-attendance at training</u> or <u>poor attitude</u> - and all players must be made to feel that they have been worthy contributors to the game.
