BOROONDARA POWER Representative Teams: INFORMATION

The Boroondara Netball Association consists of over 300 community & school netball teams. 'Boroondara Power' teams form our Talent Identification Program, a "Pathway to the Top" for talented players to ultimately reach the **Boroondara EXPRESS** Victorian Netball League teams via underage representative teams. TEAMS to be SELECTED:	13U & 15U: 3 teams each 17U & 19U: 1 team each (note: our top 17U & 19U players are selected in VNL and VNL Talent squads)			
	<i>Note: VNL Talent squad (ETS) is selected with VNL trials, not Power</i>			
	Players are selected for 2 seasons : Terms 1&2 / Terms 3&4 We reserve the right to select additional or less teams depending on standard and coach availability			
ELIGIBILITY:	ALL players must be active members of the Boroondara Netball Association: <i>Players must be members of BNA either as a player/ coach/ umpire or have been in the Boroondara Power talent pathway previously. Only our VNL teams are open to the community.</i>			
COACHING STAFF:	Minimum NCAS Development accreditation, working towards Intermediate / Advanced accreditation			
TRAINING: <i>(provisional)</i>	Boroondara Sports Complex: 4 court stadium, 279 Belmore Rd Nth Balwyn,

COMMITMENT:	CODE OF CONDUCT: All players and parents are required to sign a "Player/ Parent Agreement" form, confirming their support of the coach, umpires, team and association. TIME: Players must commit to attend training once per weeks and all matches <i>Please do NOT apply if you are unable to COMMIT to training and match commitments!</i>			
FINANCIAL COMMITMENT:	Player fees will be approx. \$360 per season – this includes coaching, indoor court hire, team registration, umpires, Association championships / special clinics etc so there are no additional costs. All players must also have State Membership . This will be arranged on acceptance.			
UNIFORM:	All players will need to buy uniform (minimum A-line dress + training shirt + tracksuit) via the on-line shop Other items are available for purchase on the website shop if wanted.
