| COMMITMENT: | CODE OF CONDUCT: All players and parents are required to sign a "Player/ Parent Agreement" form, confirming their support of the coach, umpires, team and association. TIME: Players must commit to attend training once per weeks and all matches Please do NOT apply if you are unable to COMMIT to training and match commitments! | | | |
| FINANCIAL COMMITMENT: | Player fees will be approx. \$350 per season – this includes coaching, indoor court hire, team registration, umpires, Association championships / special clinics etc so there are no additional costs. All players must also have State Membership . This will be arranged on acceptance. | | | |
| UNIFORM: | All players will need to buy uniform (minimum A-line dress + training shirt + tracksuit) via the on-line shop Other items are available for purchase on the website shop if wanted. | | | |
